

Summer Assignments for Rising 2nd Graders



As we prepare for an exciting year ahead in 2nd grade, I'd like to provide some simple summer work to help your child stay sharp and ready for the new school year. To support continued learning over the summer, your child is asked to complete the following activities:

1. Read and Log 5 AR Books

Your child should read at least five AR (Accelerated Reader) books over the summer and record them on the attached log sheet. These books should be appropriate for their reading level (use their range from EOY Star Testing in first grade). Feel free to visit your local library or access digital books on Epic! to complete this goal. You can also use Accelerated Reader Bookfinder US to help see if and what level other books are.

2. Two Book Reports

After reading two of the five books, your child should complete a short book report for each one (forms provided). Each report should include:

- The book's title and author
- Their favorite character and description of setting
- Their favorite part
- A simple drawing related to the book

➤ **Important:** One of the two book reports will be presented to the class during the first week of school. This presentation will count as your child's **first reading grade** for 2nd grade.

3. Math Facts Practice

Your child should complete:

- One Addition Facts Page (5 minutes)
- One Subtraction Facts Page (7 minutes)

These timed practice sheets help build fluency with basic math facts, which is a key skill in 2nd grade. Don't worry if your child takes a little longer—encourage accuracy and a positive attitude!

All summer assignments should be returned during the **first day of school**. Your support in helping your child complete these activities is greatly appreciated and will give them a strong start to the year.
