### **Summer Reading Assignment**

#### **Reading Requirements:**

- Read four Accelerated Reader (A.R.) books over the summer.
- At least two of the books must be nonfiction.
- Two of the books must each be worth at least 1 A.R. point.
- Write a paragraph about two of the four books you read.

We encourage students to choose books with a reading level of 3.0 or higher. We also recommend that students keep a list of the A.R. books they read, as they may take A.R. tests on those books when they return to school. However, taking the A.R. tests is not required.

#### **Paragraph Instructions:**

- Write both paragraphs in pencil on loose-leaf, lined paper.
- Use a separate sheet of paper for each paragraph.
- Be sure to include the student's name at the top of each page.
- The paragraphs are due on the first day of school.
