4K Program Overview

Welcome to All Saints' Episcopal Day School

At All Saints', we provide a nurturing, faith-based education where academic growth, spiritual development, and character are equally valued. Rooted in the Judeo-Christian tradition through the Anglican faith, our mission is to help each child reach their highest potential while fostering compassion, service, and a love for learning. From our youngest learners in 2K through 6th grade, we create a supportive and inclusive community where children grow in knowledge, faith, and friendship.

Curriculum Snapshot

Our 4K program blends engaging, research-based resources with developmentally appropriate practices to prepare children for Kindergarten success.

- **Lively Letters® Phonics** – A multi-sensory phonics program that uses stories, songs, and motion cues to bring letters and sounds to life, accelerating phonemic awareness and letter–sound mastery.
- **Handwriting Without Tears®** – A hands-on handwriting curriculum that builds fine motor strength, pencil grip, and letter formation through tactile tools, simplified strokes, and multi-sensory activities.
- **My Big World Scholastic Magazine** – A preschool magazine that introduces science and social studies concepts through seasonal themes, real-world photos, and engaging classroom activities.
- **Whole-Group, Small-Group & Individual Work** – A balanced instructional model provides opportunities for shared learning, targeted small-group instruction, and individualized practice to meet each child's needs.
- **Learning Centers Across Domains** – Children explore literacy, math, science, construction, creativity, and pretend play in structured centers that foster independence, collaboration, and curiosity.



A Day in the Life of 4K

Each day in 4K balances structured learning with enrichment, play, and time to rest and reflect.

- **Arrival & Morning Meeting** – Readiness activities and a community circle (with Chapel twice weekly and a Spirit Assembly on Fridays).
- **Language Arts & Calendar** – Early reading, phonics, and vocabulary woven into daily routines.
- **Core Instruction** – *Handwriting Without Tears®*, literacy, and math build strong foundations.

- **Centers & Small Groups** – Hands-on exploration in math, literacy, science, construction, pretend play, creativity, and fine motor skills, along with targeted teacher support.
- **Enrichment** – Weekly specials in Spanish, PE, Art, Music, Technology, Library, and STEM.
- **Snack, Lunch, Rest & Recess** – Time to recharge, play, and practice social skills.
- **Closing Circle** – Reflection and preparation for the next day.

- **Personal Meetings:** Teachers meet individually with families in the fall and spring to review progress and growth, as measured through daily observations and ongoing assessments.
