



ACCELERATED READER PROGRAM 2025-2026

Welcome to the Accelerated Reader Program! At All Saints', we believe that reading is a vital life skill. A.R. is a fun, rewarding program designed to encourage reading while building fluency and confidence.

About A.R.

A.R. is a computerized reading program beginning in first grade. It's individualized and noncompetitive—students choose books from the A.R. list at their reading level and pace. Each book has a point value based on its difficulty. After reading, students take a quiz and earn points based on correct answers.

Important Information

- Students will take the STAR Reading test during the first full week of school. Teachers use these results, along with classroom observations, to assign an individualized reading range (will increase throughout the year) and a corresponding yearlong point goal.
- A.R. quizzes may only be taken at school during school hours: Monday–Friday, 7:50 AM–3:00 PM.

Acceptable Ways to Read A.R. Books:

1. Student reads independently
2. Parent reads or shares the book
3. Teacher reads aloud to the class
4. Student listens to an approved, unabridged audiobook

Note: Cliff Notes, movies, videos, or abridged versions are not allowed. *Students must take quizzes independently.*

Finding A.R. Books

Library books at All Saints' are color-coded by reading level. You can also search for titles at www.arbookfind.com to check if a book has an A.R. quiz.

Two-Part Rewards System

1. Individual Goals and End-of-Year Party

2nd–6th Grade: Each student receives a yearlong point goal based on STAR test data and teacher input. To attend the A.R. Party (May 15), students must:

- Meet their point goal by May 8
- Maintain at least 85% average quiz comprehension

Quarterly benchmarks help students stay on track, but only the final total matters for party eligibility. Testing toward the yearlong goal begins Monday, August 25, following STAR test results. Students meeting their year-long goal by May 8th will be invited to the End-of-Year A.R. Party (details to be announced).

1st Grade follows the same structure, except the first quarter is a trial period. Goals begin in the 2nd quarter, with an 80% comprehension target (due to number of questions). Students may earn Flash Points starting in the 1st quarter.

2. Flash Points and School-wide Awards

In addition to individual goals, 1st–6th graders can earn Flash Point prizes for accumulating A.R. points throughout the year. Students are responsible for tracking and submitting points.

Mid-Year Incentives!

- ★ Students who reach 150 points (1st–3rd) or 175 points (4th–6th) by December 19th will become Teacher Assistant for the Day.
- ★ Students who reach 200 points (1st–3rd) or 225 points (4th–6th) by December 19th will enjoy Lunch with Mr. Powell or Mrs. Quesada!

Recognitions

Recognitions take place Fridays in the MPB from 8:10–8:30 AM. Recognition is based on cumulative points at the end of each term.
