

performance, service, and worship, it is our dedicated faculty and staff who truly set us apart. Their boundless passion, love, and commitment to nurturing our students define the heart of our community.



## What is the Annual Fund?

The Annual Fund is one of our most important sources of revenue. Tuition covers only 75% of the total cost of a student's education. Gifts to the Annual Fund bridge the gap between tuition income and the full cost of an All Saints' education. Unlike tuition, Annual Fund donations are tax deductible to the extent allowable by law.

Every year, the Annual Fund gifts help the school invest in our incredible faculty, maintain a low student-teacher ratio even with overall enrollment growth, enhance our classroom resources, create new programs and professional development opportunities, and continue All Saints' commitment to providing a high quality, student centered education to all families.
